

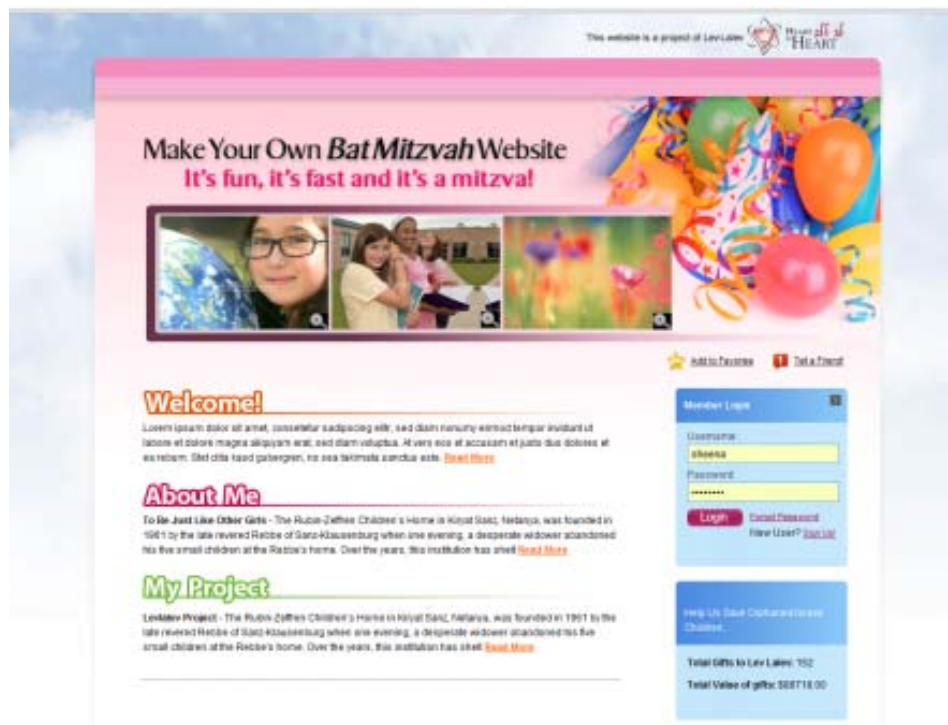
## My Bat Mitzvah Instructions

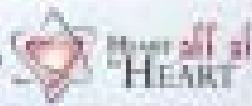

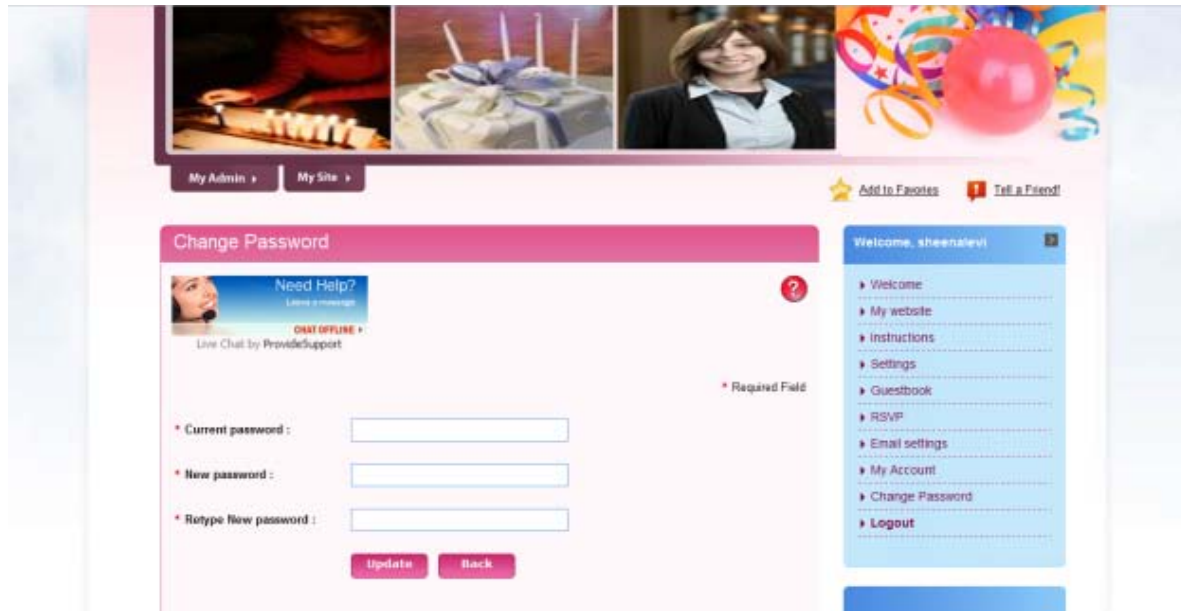

You can now start editing and customizing your personal webpage.

The **My Admin** tab on the left is where you will make all the changes, the **My Site** tab next to it is where you can go to look at how your changes are showing up on your webpage, how your viewers will see your site.

Along the right hand side is where all your admin options are, we'll go through them one by one, but before that you will want to set up your custom settings.

In the **Welcome** menu on the right go to **Settings** and here you can pick what pages you want on your site, if you want any news you post and Lev LaLev posted news to be shown to your users, and your email settings, I recommend making it so you do receive all email alerts. When you are done click **Update**.

When you reach "end of your material" if you select "another" again, nothing interesting will be added to your site. This will be repeated in each of the "other" sections, but you can't go back to see how your changes look on the site.

Header Settings

## Step Four – Interacting with your visitors

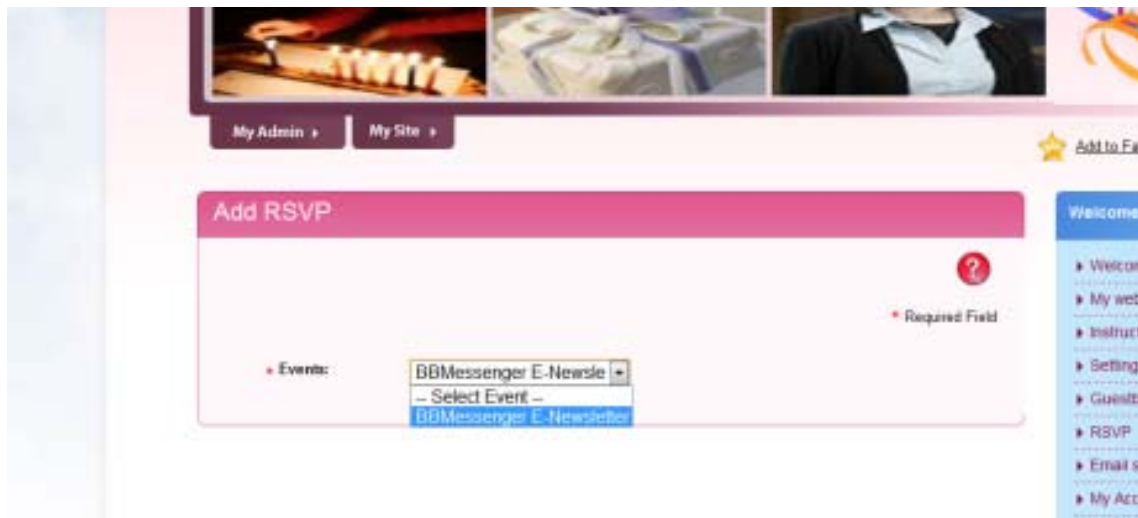
Continuing down our **Welcome** admin menu we have:

**Instructions**- don't worry about that, these are your instructions, or email me at [sheena@levlalev.com](mailto:sheena@levlalev.com) if you have any questions

**Settings** we have already discussed in step two.

**Guestbook** - once you have some posts you can edit the posts here if you wish to delete or respond to any comments.

**RSVP** - If you want people to use your site to rsvp to an event you have created go to **RSVP -> Events** and select the event you have already created.



You'll now be sent to a menu to add any rsvp questions, like how many people your guest will be bringing, etc. You can also choose to allow your guest to comment about the event or not. When you are done click **submit**.



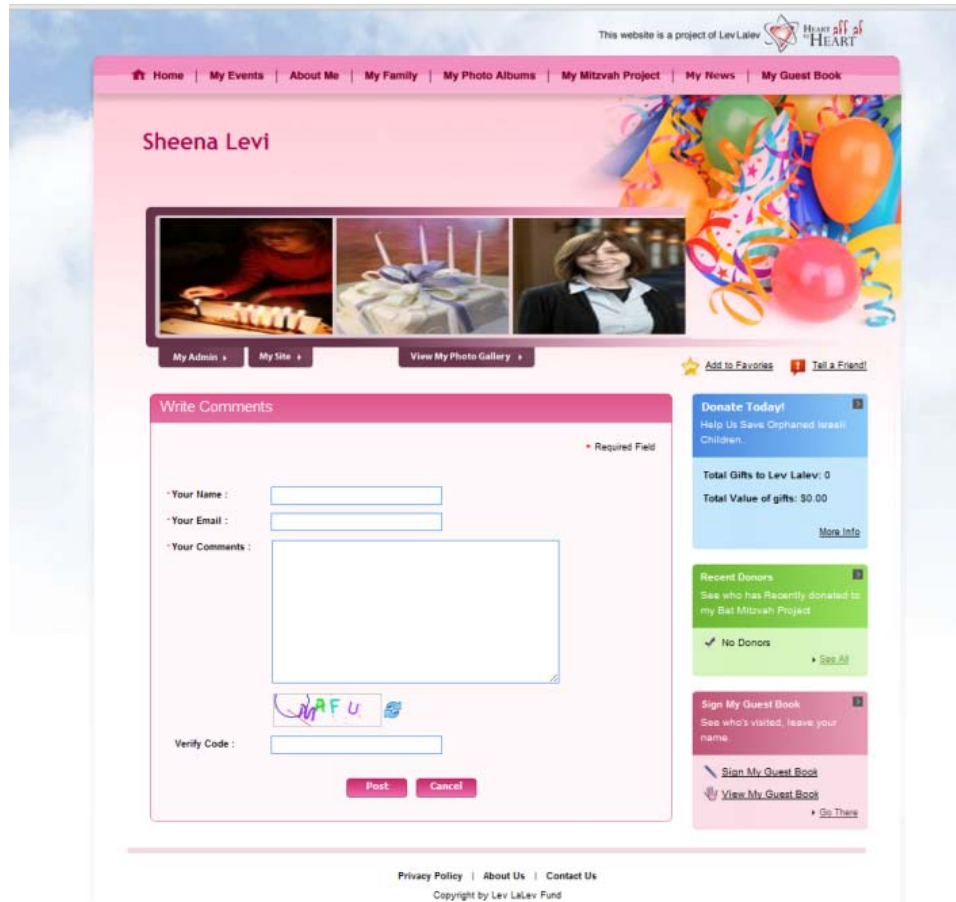

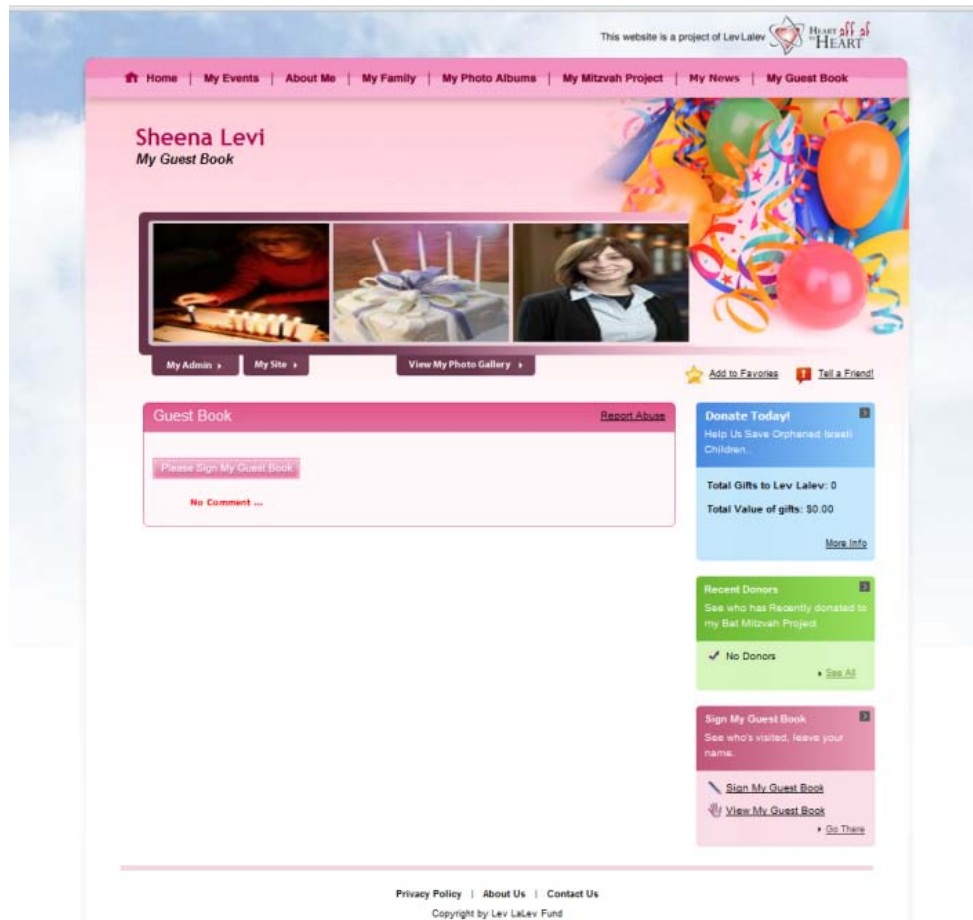
